Please re-read our illness policy!

If your child is not feeling well (fever, undiagnosed rash, cough, watery eyes, diarrhea, vomiting, etc.), it is better to keep them home. **They must be fever free and no diarrhea or vomiting for 24 hours.** We cannot admit a child for the day if the above symptoms are present. If a child should develop these symptoms during the day, the parent will be contacted to make arrangements to pick up their child. If we are unable to reach you, or if you have not made arrangements to pick up your child within the hour, we will call your emergency contact person. **A child may not come back to the program for 24 hours after being sent home. A child must be free of fever, vomiting, or diarrhea for 24 hours before returning to school.** A temporary solution (such as Tylenol or Motrin) is unacceptable according to state licensing standards.

No child will be kept inside while the class is on the playground. If a child is too ill to play outside, they are too ill to come to school.
